

Regional Offices: Benefits


- Regional offices can provide a platform for implementing the goals and principles of the European Research Area in the field of forest research.
- They allow the regions to benefit from EFI's pan-European network and research expertise.
- They help regional experts, institutions and governments to address issues of importance for their regions in a European context.



Regional Offices: Benefits

- pool financial and other resources for tackling important issues.
- reduce the fragmentation of research structures.
- increase the effectiveness of the participating institutes through co-ordinated collaboration.
- allow EFI to be more visibly present in Europe's regions.


