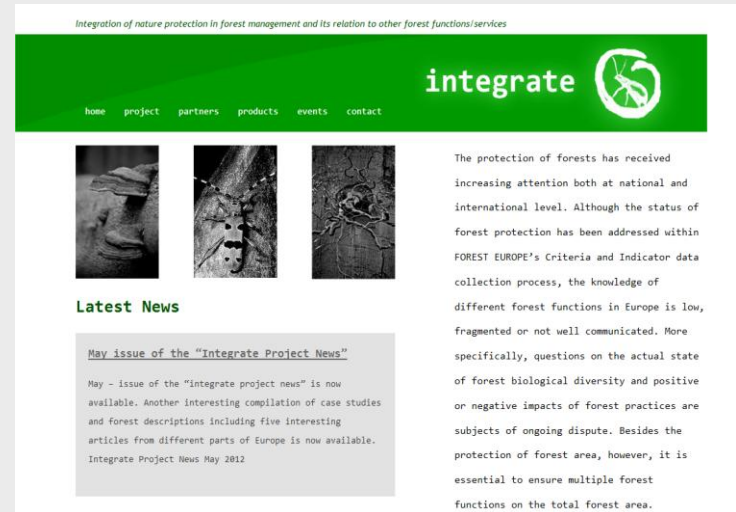
# Integration of nature protection in forest management
